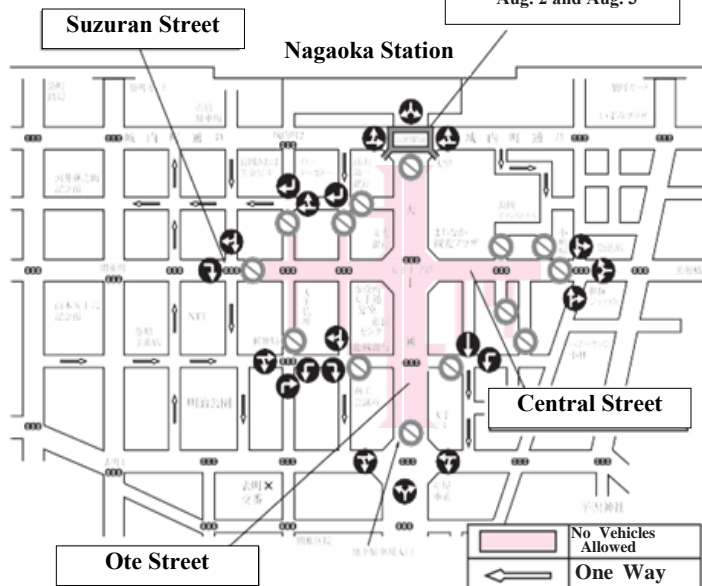

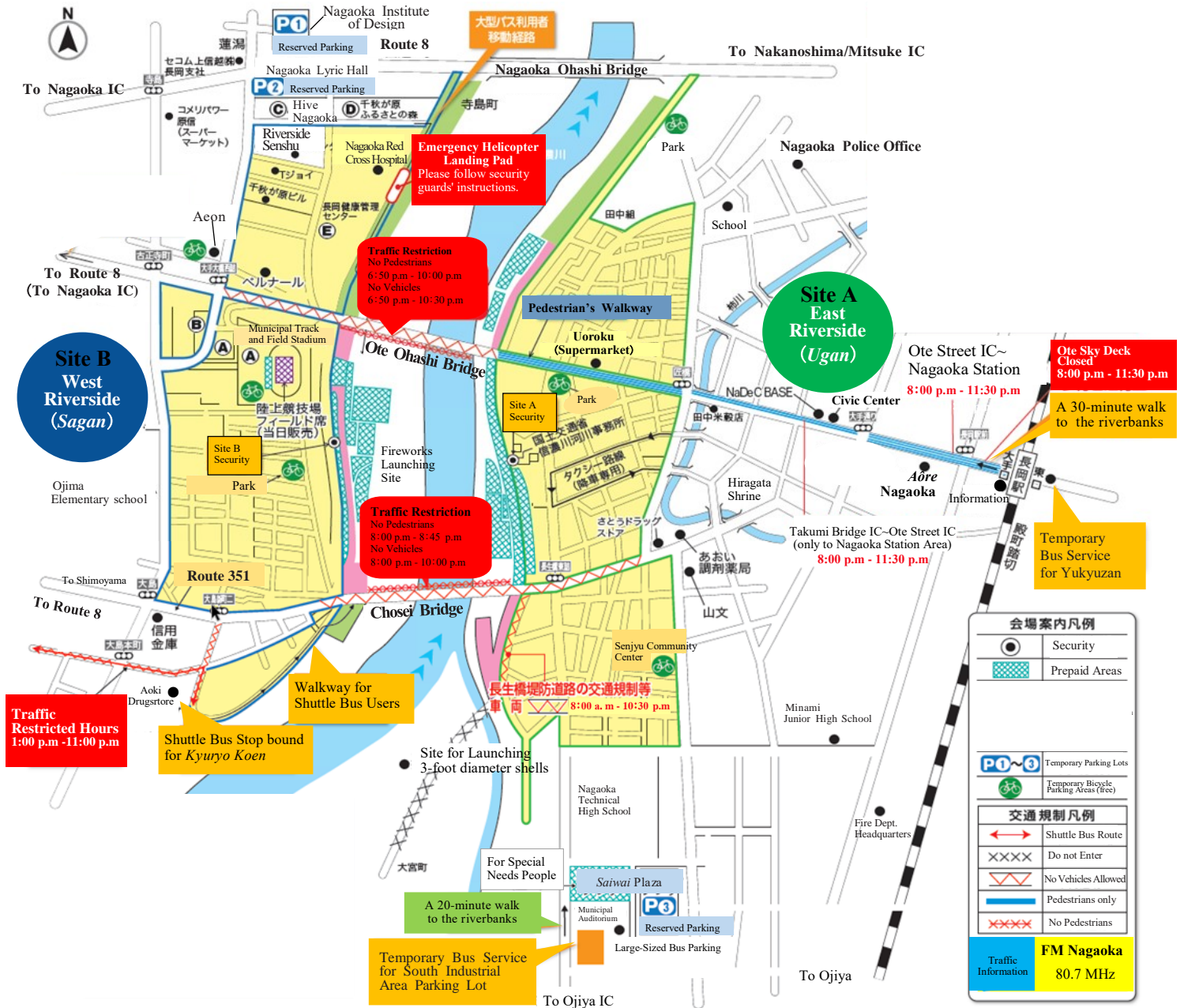

Your Cooperation Is Most Appreciated!

- For this year's Nagaoka Festival Grand Fireworks Show, all fireworks viewing sites will require prepaid tickets. If you wish to watch the fireworks at the fireworks viewing sites, you will need tickets for *yûryō kanranseki* (prepaid areas).
- "Park and Ride" is recommended to reduce traffic jams during the Fireworks Show. Park your vehicle at a designated parking lot (e.g. Municipal Auditorium in Saiwai-cho, Echigo Hillside Park, Koshiji and Mishima Branch Offices, etc.) and use a shuttle bus service or a train to get to a fireworks viewing site.
- Park your bicycle at designated free bicycle parking areas. (See the map.)
- After 6:00 p.m., prepaid areas are very crowded, which can make them dangerous. It will take much longer to get to your seating areas because it is getting dark after 6:00 p.m.. Do not rush to enter your area.
- Driving back from the fireworks viewing sites is not easy. After the show, traffic comes to a standstill because everyone starts leaving the sites all at once. Expect heavy traffic congestion around the fireworks viewing sites and the Nagaoka Interchange to continue into the late night.
